## Make a reading tree






Keep track of the books you read by creating a reading tree. Create a trunk with branches and add each book as a leaf. Wait till you see how much you've accomplished!

## What you'll need

- \* A large sheet of paper or poster board
- \* Brown, green, red, and yellow construction paper (or colored pens or markers)
- \* Pen or marker
- \* Scissors
- \* Tape
- \* Glue
- \* Ziplock bag
- \* Tacks







## How to do it

- \* Cut out a trunk and branches for the tree with the brown construction paper.
- \* Tape the tree to a wall where you can reach the branches.
- \* Cut out leaves with the green, red and yellow construction paper.
- \* Fill out the first leaf with a book you've read recently. Include the title of the book, the author, and the date when the book was read.
- \* Glue the leaf onto one of the branches.
- \* Place the empty leaves in a ziplock bag with a pen. You can keep the bag next to the tree. Every time you read a book, fill out a leaf and add it to your reading tree.
